

Activity Report 2016

Various donations were realised during the year.

Most of the donations were invested in the project "Day Centre" in Bucharest. This is a day-care facility open to the most deprived children. The donations are used to fund a three-year contract with a local catering company providing daily and balanced meals for children attending the host organisation.

The donations collected also made it possible to use a psychologist in charge of supporting and consulting future students in their educational orientation.

Various meetings of the committee of STUDY-HELP took place during the year.

The President of STUDY-HELP travelled to Romania in June with a delegation of the Round Table Luxembourg:

- Interviews with sponsored students and new applicants
- Visit of the St Iosif Foyer in Odorheiu
- Follow-up of the project "Day Centre" in Bucharest

All the members of the committee of STUDY-HELP travelled at one's own expense to Romania in December 2016:

- Signature of new student sponsorship contracts
- Signature of sponsorship extension contracts for students who have successfully completed their "bachelor" and who are pursuing a "master"
- Conversation with the on-site contact persons in charge of verifying and justifying the academic results of the sponsored students
- Visit of the St Iosif Foyer in Odorheiu
- Follow-up of the project "Day Centre" in Bucharest

In 2016, twelve students completed successfully their bachelor's degree. As outlined above, eleven of them decided to continue with a master's degree so that their sponsorship was extended.

Two students have stopped their studies and are no longer sponsored.

The number of sponsored students has increased again compared to last year: STUDY-HELP asbl is very proud to announce the sponsorship of 41 students in Romania and one student in Thailand for the academic year 2016/2017 and of which 23 students are enrolled in master's degree.
